Florida law requires a notary public to maintain legal residency in the State of Florida during the entire term of the appointment. § 117.01(1), Fla. Stat. If you are no longer a legal resident of Florida, you must submit your resignation to the Governor immediately. Please complete the change of address form above and sign the resignation letter below.
